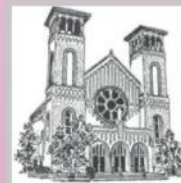

Those who say, "I know [Jesus]," but do not keep his commandments are liars, and the truth is not in them. - 1 Jn 2:4

"I don't do anything that bad, Father."

I hear this line in confession a lot. To some extent, it's probably true. If we consider the Ten Commandments at their most basic form, most of us are not murderers, adulterers, thieves, or liars. But to look at the Ten Commandments in this most basic way is not enough. At least, not according to Jesus. Jesus calls us to be perfect as our heavenly Father is perfect. And if we examine ourselves well, we are far from perfect. The great saints of the Church knew that they were great sinners, and if they were then we probably are as well.

Every sin hurts someone in some way. What we perceive as "not that bad" may be very bad from someone else's perspective. Often our sins seem smaller in our own eyes, but they may be very great in the eyes of others or in the eyes of God.

St. John tells us that when we don't obey the commandments - when we sin - it leads to us not knowing Jesus. We can pray all we want, we can feel close to God, but if our behavior does not reflect that closeness, there is a serious disconnect and we are deceived. In John's words, we are liars.

I would encourage all Catholics who haven't in a while to look at a detailed examination of conscience. A good examination of conscience helps us to be aware of the sin in our lives. It takes some time to do and it will not feel great. No one wants to feel like a sinner. But it is too easy to assume that my sins are small sins and small sins don't matter that much. We do not want to be deceiving ourselves. A good examination helps us to be realistic about our sins and grateful to be offered redemption and forgiveness.

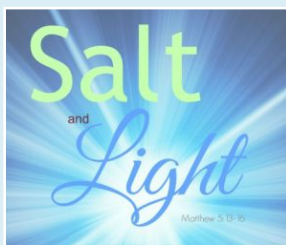


## In & Around Our Neighborhood...

If you are interested in purchasing lots at any of our cemeteries, please call the parish office. **PLEASE REMEMBER:** No shrubs or small trees are permitted to be planted in the cemeteries. What may seem "small & cute" eventually turns into "overgrown & hard work" when a family no longer cares for the shrub or tree. Flowers are so much more colorful.
